Il year old Victor* is a great kid with a sweet smile and great laugh.
Unfortunately, he had been sick, really sick for a while with a fever, painful cough and difficulty breathing.

Victor's grandmother brought him to Santa Clotilde since his parents could not afford to come down river. The diagnosis was also clear - a giant pneumonia and fluid collection in his lungs.

Normally, we would send a patient like Victor to Iquitos for hospitalization and a chest tube in the closest city, by 4-5 hour boat ride. Like many of the thousands of people cared for by the staff at Santa Clotilde, Victor's

family could not afford to send Victor to Iquitos.

So, we've been taking good care of him and letting his smiles and laughs bolster our spirits. He is getting better with regular fluid thoracentesis, antibiotics and a little soccer with myself and card games with Shantha.

He may be here a little longer than he would otherwise, due to the lack of resources, but we're making it work.

This story of little Victor came from short-term Mission Doctors, Andrew Luckett and Shantha Parameswaran and their time serving at Santa Clotilde Clinic on the Napo River in rural Peru.


