Hello from Uganda! I wanted to give you an update on the Pediatric and Nursery for sick babies at St. Francis hospital. We have been working on projects over the last few years, trying to help this very much needed area of the hospital. Troubles in the past have been that it's overcrowded, the power has been unreliable, which has limited the type of treatments we could give. But in the last year, between the work of many people which includes the hospital administration, the medical and nursing staff here, Friends of Uganda, Mission Doctors Association and the friends of the Coda familymuch help has been given!

Batteries now provide a reliable power source. Before, the power would cut out and infants that were dependent on oxygen would do without and some

would even die.

And, now that we have a reliable source, we can use incubators for the very small, the one to two kilogram babies. For those dependent on oxygen, they can have that now and have the help of specialized pressure machines, CPAPs. With this additional help of basic care, we have done much better. The staff at the hospital is encouraged, families are encouraged and I'm encouraged. So on behalf of all of us, thank you very much.

This came from Dr. Lou and Mrs. Martha Coda who have been serving for several months each year at St. Francis Hospital in rural Uganda, East Africa. Your support provides the loving hands, the machines and batteries leading to Tiny Miracles in Uganda.
