Health Fair Brings Hope and Answered Prayers

The health fair was a significant success, offering free consultations, lab testing, and much-needed medications to patients. “We initially expected around 200 people,” Dr. Kronenberger shared, “but nearly 800 showed up, and we were able to treat about 500 patients that day.”

Thanks to the generosity of you, our supporters, Mission Doctors Dr. Crystal Kronenberger, Dr. Brian and Dr. Robyn Jennings and the dedicated local staff recently hosted an impactful health fair at Nyakibale Hospital in rural Uganda.

To our donors, we offer heartfelt thanks. Your contributions made this life-changing event possible, extending Christ’s healing hands to a community in need. The work is far from over, but together, we are making a difference—one patient at a time.

The event was designed to address common but often untreated medical conditions in the local community, such as hypertension, diabetes, malaria, and arthritis. Many in this region face barriers to healthcare due to financial constraints. This event allowed patients to receive care when they would have otherwise done without.

This overwhelming turnout highlights the critical need for accessible healthcare in rural Uganda. For many attendees, this was their first opportunity to receive medical attention in years.

The supplies and medications, all donated by our supporters, made it possible for Mission Doctors to treat a wide range of conditions, though the sheer volume of patients meant that supplies ran out sooner than expected.



“Many people in this region wait too long or go without medical care due to lack of resources,” Dr. Kronenberger noted. “Your donations directly funded the lab tests and medications that brought healing to hundreds of Ugandans.”

Local healthcare professionals worked closely with the Mission Doctors team to provide seamless care. Despite the challenges, the team's collaboration ensured that they could focus on the most urgent medical needs, providing essential services to patients who might otherwise go without.
